4.1	Treasurer's Report	Donna Belley provided her Treasurer's Report which included a Membership and Financial Summary. Membership highlights We had a total of 185 members (2021/22 – 209 members), a decrease of 24 members. Highlights Males – 139 members or 75% (2021/22 - 71.3%) Female – 46 members or 25% (2021/22 - 28.7%) Financial Report For our Operating Account, as outlined in the attached Financial Statements, our Revenue for the year is \$42,328. Expenditures totaled \$26,878. Leaving a net profit of \$15450.31.
		 Revenue Highlights: Net membership revenue was \$22,695. Junior Program Revenue: \$10,000. Spring and Summer Drop in Revenue: \$5,795 School Program Revenue \$2,200. Schools enrolled in the school program were charged a fee of \$125/day. Slightly down from \$2,625 from 2021/22. Guest Fee Revenue \$540. Tournament revenue: \$928. Includes revenue from Tennis Albert of \$1,244 less expenses of \$650.
		 Expenditure Highlights: Employment Contracts – This has been a difficult season for our Club in terms of offering our Junior Programs. It was very hard to hire a tennis instructor as the whole of Edmonton was experiencing a shortage of instructors this year. Our Board was fortunate to hire Peter Skoda in late May at a much higher cost than in previous years. For our Club to offer

the Spring Drop-in Program and School Outreach program our Junior Coordinator provided the instruction to these programs. We also hired an assistant instructor for June. Total employment contract expenditure 2023 \$7,297. Outstanding amount \$9300 which will be paid in 2023/24 fiscal year. • Bambora Fees \$1,220 Transaction fees total 3% per transaction plus a monthly fee of \$15.00. • Social Functions - \$2,480 We held several social events this season: October 2022 AGM meeting. May – Open House • June – Junior Spring Wrap up, June 10 Club Social • July – Club Social and Doubles Tournament August – Club Social • September – Club Championship • Utilities Shaw Internet - \$478 Enmax Electricity - \$2,774 • Direct Energy – Gas – \$675 Water/Sewer Trash - \$857 As per the Club Bylaws the financial statements are to be audited by two members of the club.
